

The War Memorials and Rolls of Honour **Of Twickenham, Middlesex**

This document is the Twickenham section from a much larger document covering all parishes within the area covered by West Middlesex Family History Society. The rest of this Introduction is as it was published in the larger document, which was made available as a CD in 2002.

This collection of War Memorials and Rolls of Honour from the area covered by the West Middlesex Family History Society has been gathered over the past fifteen years (1987 – 2002) from many different sources by a number of transcribers, to whom we owe a huge debt of gratitude.

The information has been found in a variety of places, not only public War Memorials placed in prominent places in the areas concerned, but also in churches of all denominations and Town Halls, offices and factories, schools and scout huts, newspapers and school magazines, a housing estate and a swimming baths, cemeteries and parks, Service Clubs and a golf club, Banks and Post Offices, and one or two in collections of papers in Local Record Offices.

These Memorials and Rolls of Honour celebrate the commitment of men and women from 1849 to 1995 who were prepared to lay down their lives in the service of their Country. Civilians who were killed by enemy action are also commemorated.

In preparing this collection I have taken the liberty of standardising the format of the Memorials to aid the researcher in seeking out a name. Whatever the style of the Memorial or Roll of Honour, I have put the surname first, followed by other names or initials. I have also arranged them in strict alphabetical order, although in some cases this is not how the names are presented on the original Memorial.

Many, many names appear on more than one memorial but where the same name appears more than once on the same Memorial or Roll of Honour, it refers to two different men who bear the same name. In searching for an entry, do remember that some Memorials carry only the initials of first names, while others give these in full, therefore it is necessary to search carefully through the index. The Appendix contains Memorials that arrived too late to be included in the main section but I felt should be included.

Care has been taken to check as many entries as possible, but should mistakes have occurred, please let me know. If you know of a War Memorial or Roll of Honour that has not been included here please notify me so that it can be added to the list held by the Society.
